
RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED;
DEADLINE ESTABLISHED**

On December 2, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. The motion explains that the company and Commission Staff recently convened a settlement conference and are continuing discussions to attempt to reach an agreement resolving all issues in this docket. The motion indicates that the parties will provide an update on settlement by December 10, 2025, and that if the parties do not reach an agreement, they will seek to schedule a procedural conference to discuss next steps in this docket. The motion seeks expedited consideration and notes that Staff supports the motion.

Based on the representations in PacifiCorp's motion, I grant it and the procedural schedule is suspended. The parties must file a settlement update by 3:00 p.m. on December 10, 2025. I also ask that the parties maintain a calendar hold for the January 6, 2026, oral argument, in case needed.
