
RULING

DISPOSITION: WAIVER REQUEST GRANTED; DEADLINES ESTABLISHED

On December 8, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion to admit stipulation and request for waiver on behalf of it and Commission Staff. The motion states the parties move to admit a stipulation reflecting the agreements between the company and Staff and the attestation of Adam Lint into the record of these proceedings. The motion explains that the parties seek to file the stipulation as soon as possible to notify the Commission that the disputed issues in this proceeding have been resolved and that the stipulation would be filed concurrently with the motion. The motion requests a waiver of OAR 860-001-0350(7)'s requirement that settlements between parties be accompanied by joint testimony or a supporting brief at the time of filing. The motion explains that the parties intend to file a supporting joint brief by December 18, 2025.

Based on the representations in the motion, I grant the request for a waiver of OAR 860-001-0350(7) as it relates to the stipulation that was filed in this docket on December 8, 2025. The parties are required to file joint testimony and/or a supporting brief by 3:00 p.m. on December 18, 2025. I will not rule on the parties' request to admit the stipulation and attestation into the evidentiary record at this time. The parties must file any additional motion(s) to admit testimony and exhibits into the evidentiary record and any declarations in support by 3:00 p.m. on December 22, 2025.
