RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED; STIPULATION, TESTIMONY, AND
EXHIBITS ADMITTED; RECORD CLOSED**

On December 8, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion to admit stipulation and request for waiver on behalf of it and Public Utility Commission of Oregon Staff. The motion stated the parties moved to admit a stipulation reflecting the agreements between the company and Staff and the attestation of Adam Lint into the record of these proceedings. I granted the motion on December 9, 2025, as it related to the waiver request and declined to rule at that time on the request to admit the stipulation and attestation into the record.

On December 22, 2025, PacifiCorp filed a motion to admit testimony and exhibits along with a supporting declaration from its witness. On December 22, 2025, Commission Staff filed a motion to admit testimony and exhibits with supporting declarations from its witnesses. No responses to the motions or objections were filed.


