**DISPOSITION: TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO

In lieu of a hearing, the parties in this docket agreed to move their testimony into the record in writing without cross-examination. Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submitted a motion and affidavits on July 31, 2007. The affidavits included attachments showing deletions to previously filed testimony. No party objected to the submission of these attachments. The Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) submitted a motion and affidavit on July 25, 2007. Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU) submitted a motion and affidavit on July 27, 2007.
