DISPOSITION: CROSS-EXAMINATION SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED


On April 14, 2009, Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities (ICNU). The Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon and the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon submitted filings stating that they do not intend to conduct cross-examination, but reserve the right to question the witnesses called by other parties regarding testimony elicited at the hearing.
