RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED; MOTION  
TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On December 10, 2009, the Oregon Industrial Customers of Idaho Power (OICIP) filed its petition to intervene in this proceeding and on December 11, 2009, submitted a motion to admit Greg Adams as counsel *pro hac vice* for OICIP.

Mr. Adams submitted an affidavit in support of OICIP's motion, along with a certificate of good standing from the Idaho State Bar and a certificate of liability insurance. Mr. Adams' affidavit states that he will associate with Peter J. Richardson, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar, who will participate meaningfully in this docket.

The Commission has received no objections within the allowed time period from any party OICIP's petition or motion for *pro hac vice*. I have considered OICIP's filings and find that Mr. Adams has satisfied the requirements of Oregon Uniform Trial Court Rule 3.170. I also find that OICIP's participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay this proceeding. See OAR 860-012-0001.

The Oregon Industrial Customers of Idaho Power are GRANTED party status and Greg Adams is ADMITTED as counsel *pro hac vice* for OICIP. Mr. Adams is additionally GRANTED "Qualified Person" status under the Protective Order entered in this docket, pursuant to his signatory page on file herein.
