RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On April 30, 2019, Idaho Power Company filed a motion to suspend the procedural schedule. Idaho Power represents that the parties have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all issues, and that time is needed to finalize and execute a settlement stipulation. Idaho Power states it has conferred with Staff and CUB and they agree to the requested suspension.

RULING

Good cause exists to grant the motion. The motion to suspend procedural schedule is granted. The settlement stipulation, and supporting testimony or brief should be filed no later than May 17, 2019. *Optional:* The supporting testimony or brief should identify any significant power cost issues the parties investigated in discovery. *See Portland General Electric Company*, Docket No. UE 346, Order No. 18-466 (Dec 17, 2018) (“Similarly, for Staff and stakeholders, when a stipulation is filled before responsive testimony is filed, we ask for the parties to include in their joint supporting testimony or supporting brief a description of any issues they identified and evaluated. We make these requests not due to any concerns in this docket, but to help provide additional context to the proceeding to better inform Commission decision-making.”) Finally, if Idaho Power would like to include its initial testimony in the record, please also file a motion to admit with a declaration or affidavit of Courtney Waites.
