RULING

**DISPOSITION: DEADLINE FOR RESPONSES SET**

PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power, filed a motion to amend Order No. 19-351. PacifiCorp asks the Commission to modify the order to allow for testimony and a Commissioner workshop in the 2021 Transition Adjustment Mechanism (TAM) proceeding, rather than the currently-ordered update to the Jim Bridger fuel plan. PacifiCorp states that it is authorized to represent that the stipulating parties do not oppose the motion: Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC); the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC (Calpine Solutions); and Commission Staff.

As provided in OAR 860-001-0420, any responses to PacifiCorp's motion are due on Monday, January 13, 2020.
