RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR LEAVE TO SUPPLEMENT REBUTTAL
TESTIMONY GRANTED**

On August 4, 2020, Sierra Club filed a motion for leave to supplement the rebuttal testimony of Dr. Jeremy Fisher. Sierra Club seeks to supplement Dr. Fisher's rebuttal testimony based on information received on July 27, 2020.

Sierra Club represents that on June 30, 2020, it submitted data request 8.2, related to a company assessment of avoided transmission associated with Jim Bridger, and that PacifiCorp's response, provided July 8, 2020, included incorrect work papers in response to request 8.2(m), and an inaccurate response to 8.2(d). Sierra Club states that on July 23, 2020, Sierra Club determined that the work papers provided in response to 8.2(m) were incorrect, and requested the correct work papers. Sierra Club indicated that its rebuttal testimony, filed on July 24, 2020, relied in part on PacifiCorp's response provided in 8.2(d). Sierra Club states that PacifiCorp provided correct work papers on July 27, 2020, and that those work papers indicated that PacifiCorp's response to 8.2(d) was inaccurate. Because Dr. Fisher's rebuttal testimony relied on PacifiCorp's response to 8.2(d), and was prepared without the benefit of the correct work papers, Sierra Club seeks to supplement Dr. Fisher's rebuttal testimony limited to addressing the corrected information.

For good cause shown, I grant Sierra Club's motion to supplement Dr. Fisher's rebuttal testimony on this limited issue.
