MEMORANDUM REGARDING
SIERRA CLUB'S MOTION FOR
ALTERNATIVE HEARING
PROCEDURES AND OBJECTION TO
DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN
INFORMATION AS
CONFIDENTIAL

On September 3, 2020, Sierra Club filed a motion to establish alternative procedures for the confidential and highly confidential portions of the upcoming evidentiary hearing to enable the use of screen sharing and video conference. The changes to the procedures for the confidential and highly confidential sessions addressed in my September 3, 2020 memorandum, and as updated today render Sierra Club's motion moot.

Additionally on September 3, 2020, Sierra Club filed an objection to PacifiCorp's designation of certain information as confidential. Sierra Club requested expedited consideration of its motion in light of the evidentiary hearings beginning on September 9, 2020. Because Sierra Club has access to information designated as confidential under the protective orders in this case, I decline to address this objection on an expedited basis. Under the terms of the protective orders issued in this docket, PacifiCorp must either remove the protected designation or filed a written response within five business days of service of the objection. Sierra Club's motion identifies the documents by reference to the designations used by the parties in discovery. To the extent that the documents have been identified as an exhibit in this docket, I request that Sierra Club provide the associated exhibit number. If the documents have not been marked as an exhibit, I request that Sierra Club provide copies of the documents.
