RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On March 26, 2020, ChargePoint, Inc. filed a motion to allow Scott F. Dunbar to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Mr. Dunbar accompanied the motion. Mr. Dunbar states that he will associate with Steve Elzinga, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Scott F. Dunbar as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of ChargePoint, Inc. is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
