RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On April 15, 2021, Sierra Club filed a motion to allow Rose Monahan and Thien Chau to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Signed statements of Ms. Monahan and Mr. Chau accompanied the motion. Ms. Monahan and Mr. Chau state that they will associate with Joshua Smith, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Rose Monahan and Thien Chau as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Sierra Club is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
