RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED, REVISED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE ESTABLISHED

On July 26, 2019, Avista Corporation dba Avista Utilities filed a motion seeking to suspend portions of the procedural schedule in this docket. Avista explains that all parties to this proceeding have reached a settlement-in-principle, and suspension of the schedule will provide time for the parties to prepare and file a stipulation and supporting testimony. The company states that the parties will file the stipulation and supporting testimony by August 14, 2019. Additionally, Avista states that the parties seek to preserve the hearing date of October 3, 2019 to provide the opportunity for testimony in support of the stipulation. The company consulted the other parties, and represents that all parties to this proceeding support this motion.

For good cause shown, Avista's motion is granted and the procedural schedule established on May 2, 2019 is suspended. The following procedural schedule is adopted.

In the event parties fail to file a settlement, the Administrative Hearings Division will set a revised procedural schedule.
