RULING

**DISPOSITION: PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED; DEADLINES
ESTABLISHED**

On March 28, 2025, Avista Corporation, Staff, Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, and Climate Solutions/Green Energy Institute at Lewis & Clark Law School (collectively, the parties) filed a motion requesting the Commission adopt an all-party stipulation and a request to suspend the procedural schedule, with the exception of the hearing date if needed for the Commission to hear joint testimony. The parties indicate they will file joint testimony in support of the stipulation by April 4, 2025.

I grant the motion to suspend the procedural schedule. Parties are requested to hold the May 29, 2025 date for an evidentiary hearing, to be scheduled if needed. Joint testimony and any other supporting documents, or a status update, are due no later than April 4, 2025, by 3:00 p.m. Motions to admit and supporting declarations are due no later than 3:00 p.m. on April 10, 2025.
