DISPOSITION: EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On March 17, 2005, the Oregon Public Utility Commission (Commission) issued Order No. 05-133, requiring PacifiCorp and Portland General Electric Company (PGE) to either file opt-out tariffs for Commission review, or submit a consensus report explaining why an opt-out plan is not workable.

On September 30, 2005, PacifiCorp filed a motion for an extension of time in which to file its opt-out tariff because it needed time to review its tariff in light of the recently issued order in UE 170 (Order No. 05-1050). PacifiCorp indicated that it could file its tariff by October 14, 2005.

PacifiCorp's motion is granted. Either the opt-out tariff or the consensus report is now due October 14, 2005.
