**DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED; NOTICE REGARDING ELECTRONIC SERVICE**

On May 6, 2004, the PGE Pension Enhancement Committee (Committee), represented by Joe Janssens and Roy Henderson, filed a petition to intervene. The Committee has sufficient interest in the proceedings, and its appearance and participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or unreasonably delay the proceeding. *See* OAR 860-013-0021. Although April 29, 2004 was the deadline for filing petitions to intervene, the Administrative Law Judge has the discretion to grant late-filed petitions. The petition to intervene is granted, subject to the filing of timely objections.

It has come to my attention that parties have not updated electronic service lists as new intervention petitions are granted. When serving documents by electronic mail, parties need to be certain that they are using the most recent electronic service list. For your assistance, this ruling is being sent by electronic mail using the current list. Parties who do not have electronic mail addresses must be served by regular mail.
