MEMORANDUM

Statements setting forth cross-examination plans and raising procedural issues that require resolution prior to next week's hearing are due today. As indicated in the Prehearing Conference Memorandum issued June 21, 2004, such statements should identify each witness to be cross-examined, include a short description of the subject matter of the cross-examination for each witness, indicate the amount of time anticipated to complete cross-examination for each witness, and identify procedural issues requiring attention. A prehearing conference in this proceeding is currently scheduled for October 20, 2004. In the absence of identifying any procedural issues requiring attention prior to next week's hearing, statements should indicate other reasons to hold the prehearing conference. If a statement identifies a need for conducting the prehearing conference, the statement should also indicate whether a morning or afternoon conference is preferred.
