DISPOSITION: MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULE GRANTED

On January 26, 2006, Staff filed a motion to amend the schedule for Phase II issues. Staff requests that the due date for submission of simultaneous direct testimony be extended from February 20, 2006, until February 27, 2006. Staff does not request any other changes to the existing schedule. Staff indicates that the requested amendment is appropriate because the current due date is a federal holiday. Staff also states that parties would benefit by having more time to prepare testimony after the hearing on Phase I compliance issues. Staff indicates that it is authorized to state that the following parties do not object to the motion to amend the schedule: Portland General Electric Company, PacifiCorp, Idaho Power, Oregon Department of Energy, Fair Rate Coalition, Sherman County Court and J. R. Simplot Company, and the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities.

As all of the active parties in the above-captioned docket do not object to the motion to amend the schedule, the motion is granted. The schedule is revised, as follows:
