DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On August 29, 2005, the City of Portland (City), along with Portland General Electric Company (PGE) and Stephen Forbes Cooper, LLC, as the Disbursing Agent for the Reserve for Disputed Claims (Cooper), filed a joint motion for an extension of time to file its testimony, currently due on September 9. Due to a delay in a response to its data requests, the City requests that its testimony instead be due on September 16. The City’s testimony is only to respond to the testimony filed by Applicants on August 10, and not any other testimony filed on September 9.

Although the parties with the strongest interest in responding to the testimony have joined the City’s motion, other intervenors will also have an opportunity to respond to the City’s testimony on September 28, and the time to review the testimony will be shortened. Therefore, the motion is conditionally granted. Any person wishing to contest the motion may do so within 15 days of service of the motion. If no person contests this motion, this decision shall be final.
