**DISPOSITION: REVISED REQUEST FOR CROSS-EXAMINATION
STATEMENTS**

In a memorandum dated March 26, 2008, I asked that each party intending to cross-examine any witness at the hearing scheduled for April 2, 2008, in the above-captioned docket, provide a statement of cross examination by 5:00 p.m., today.

I asked that each statement include:

1. Identification of each witness to be cross-examined;
2. A short description of the subject matter of the cross-examination for each witness;
3. A list of exhibits expected to be introduced at hearing and a short description of how foundation for each will be established; and
4. The anticipated amount of time needed to complete cross-examination of each witness.

In addition, I also ask that each statement indicate whether cross-examination will address any part of the highly confidential workpapers. If so, please provide information about the nature of this cross-examination and indicate whether a copy of the workpapers, or some part of the workpapers, need to be made available at the hearing. If a party's cross-examination statement has already been filed, please supplement it by providing the additional information by 5:00 p.m., today. This information may be provided by electronic mail.
