
RULING

DISPOSITION: REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On November 3, 2009, the due date for reply testimony from Staff and intervenors in this proceeding, the Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) filed a motion requesting a one-day extension of time, until November 4, 2009. CUB states that Gordon Feighner, CUB's Utility Analyst "has been out sick, and as a result CUB finds itself behind on the drafting and filing of its testimony." In its motion CUB reports that counsel for Portland General Electric Company does not oppose the motion.

CUB's motion is granted on an expedited basis. CUB shall file its testimony no later than November 4, 2009.
