
RULING

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE HELD IN CONTINUED ABEYANCE

On April 21, 2009, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) filed a status report in the above-captioned docket. Staff explains that a number of parties have reached a memorandum of understanding (MOU) that will resolve all pending matters in this docket. Staff states that those parties who will not be signatories to the MOU have indicated they will not oppose it. On behalf of all parties, Staff asks for the procedural schedule to be held in continued abeyance until the parties submit the MOU for the Commission's review and approval.

Staff's request to hold the procedural schedule in continued abeyance is GRANTED. If the MOU cannot be filed with the Commission by May 15, 2009, Staff should file an additional status report.
