
DISPOSITION: CORRECTED MOTIONS TO ADMIT COUNSEL
PRO HAC VICE GRANTED

On October 12, 2009, I granted motions to admit Greg Adams, a member in good standing of the Idaho State Bar, as counsel *pro hac vice* in dockets UM 1441, UM 1442, and UM 1443. All three motions identified Farmers Irrigation District (Farmers) as the moving party.

On October 19, 2009, the Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA) filed a corrected motion to admit Mr. Adams as counsel *pro hac vice* in UM 1442 and 1442. CREA states that the earlier motions in these two dockets erroneously identified Farmers as the moving party. These new motions properly designate CREA, and again contain an affidavit from Mr. Adams, a certificate of good standing from the Idaho State bar, a certificate of insurance covering Mr. Adam's activities in Oregon, and declaration that Mr. Adams will associate with Peter Richardson, a member of good standing in the Oregon State Bar.

The corrected motions to admit Mr. Adams as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of CREA in dockets UM 1442 and UM 1443, are granted. The earlier ruling allowing Mr. Adams to appear *pro hac vice* on behalf of Framers in docket UM 1441 remains in effect and is not affected by this ruling.
