RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; TIME EXTENDED TO FILE
REPORT

On November 24, 2014, the parties in the proceeding filed a joint motion seeking to extend, by a period of three weeks, the due date for submission of a report on the status of broadband availability in rural exchange service areas in Oregon. In support of the motion, the parties state that the current draft report is incomplete and that additional time is necessary to complete the process of gathering data and preparing a comprehensive and accurate report. No party objects to the motion.

I find that the parties have shown good cause for the delay. The motion is granted. The report on the status of broadband availability in rural exchanges in Oregon shall be filed no later than December 22, 2014.
