RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On June 2, 2014, Threemile Canyon Wind I, LLC, filed a motion to allow Corey Neal and Earle O'Donnell to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. Mr. Neal and Mr. O'Donnell state that they will associate with Richard G. Lorenz and Chad M. Stokes, active members in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Corey Neal and Earle O'Donnell *pro hac vice* on behalf of Threemile Canyon Wind I, LLC, is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.<sup>1</sup>
