**DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION NOTED**

On July 12, 2013, Obsidian Renewables LLC (“Obsidian”) filed a motion requesting clarification that the Commission’s final order entered in Phase I in the above captioned docket would address approval of renewable rates for qualified facilities (QFs). On July 29, 2013, a joint response supporting the motion was filed by three parties: the Community Renewable Energy Association, OneEnergy, Inc., and Renewable Northwest Project. The joint response provided additional background, and asked for assurance that renewable rates would be available to QFs at the conclusion of Phase I.

The motion for clarification is noted, and the Commission will consider it in the context of the rest of the record in these proceedings. We cannot otherwise address the scope of the final order to be entered in Phase I.
