
RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITION TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On January 2, 2013, Small Business Utility Advocates (SBUA) filed a petition to intervene in this docket. Upon review of the petition, I find that SBUA has sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that its participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.¹ The petition to intervene is therefore granted.

I also note that on January 3, 2013, the Citizens' Utility Board intervened as a matter of right under ORS 774.180.
