DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE*
GRANTED

On October 28, 2015, Interstate Renewable Energy Council, Inc. (IREC) filed a motion to allow Erica S. McConnell to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Ms. McConnell accompanied the motion. Ms. McConnell states that she will associate with Elisabeth Holmes, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Erica S. McConnell as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of IREC is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
