

RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On May 26, 2015 and May 27, 2015, respectively, Cypress Creek Renewables, LLC (Cypress Creek) and the Community Renewable Energy Association (CREA) filed petitions to intervene in this docket. Upon review of the petitions, I find that Cypress Creek and CREA have sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that their participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.¹ The petitions to intervene are therefore granted.
