

RULING

DISPOSITION: PETITIONS TO INTERVENE GRANTED

On June 23, 2016, and June 24, 2016 respectively, Alevo Analytics (Alevo) and SunPower Corporation (SunPower) filed a petitions to intervene in this docket. Upon review of the petitions, I find that Alevo and SunPower each have sufficient interest in the proceedings to participate and that their participation will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceedings.¹ The petitions to intervene are therefore granted.
