
MEMORANDUM

The Commission will conduct oral argument in these proceedings on November 17, 2023, starting at 10:00 a.m. This memorandum serves to inform the parties of requirements for non-attorney participation in the oral argument.

Should any party intend to have an individual who is not an Oregon-licensed attorney appear and present at the oral argument, that party must file a notice designating an authorized representative with the Filing Center by 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 16, 2023. Such notices should identify the individual and why they qualify to be an authorized representative for the party.

Such an authorized representative, as defined by OAR 860-001-0010(2), will be allowed to present at the oral argument at the discretion of the Administrative Law Judge. Such authorized representatives are expected to be familiar with the responsibilities and restrictions on authorized representatives, in particular as it relates to legal argument.¹
