**DISPOSITION: MOTION TO REVISE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE
APPROVED**

On March 21, 2008, the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission), filed a motion to extend the suspension period in this matter for an additional three months pursuant to ORS 757.215(1). The extension was requested because of issues relating to the Deschutes County foreclosure on property owned by Seventh Mountain Golf Village Water Company. On April 10, 2008, the Commission entered Order No. 08-199, extending the suspension period until September 19, 2008.

On April 7, 2008, Staff filed a request to modify the procedural schedule in this matter. Staff proposes the following schedule for the remainder of the proceeding:

Company Rebuttal Testimony Due	July 16, 2008
Deadline for Data Requests	July 7, 2008

Evidentiary Hearing	July 28, 2008 (day hearing) Location: Bend

The evidentiary hearing in this matter is currently scheduled to be held in late May. As the Staff explains in its March 21 motion, however, issues relating to the County's foreclosure may not be resolved for up to 60 days. This requires that Staff and other parties receive additional time to prepare for the evidentiary hearing. Staff's request to modify the procedural schedule, as set forth above, is therefore granted.
