RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

By motion filed August 17, 2017, the Commission Staff requests that the procedural schedule be amended to remove from the schedule the dates set for the filing of Staff/Intervenor rebuttal testimony (August 31, 2017) and Sunriver surrebuttal testimony (September 21, 2017). As grounds for its motion, Staff notes on July 7, 2017, Sunriver Owners Association (SROA) submitted an exhibit and issues lists in lieu of pre-filed testimony, and on August 2, 2017, Sunriver Water LLC (Sunriver) filed its response to Staff's opening testimony but did not put forth a witness or add additional facts. According to Staff, both SROA and Sunriver have indicated a desire to move forward with their respective issues at the hearing, rather than through pre-filed expert witness testimony to which the parties can respond in subsequent rounds of testimony. Therefore, in Staff's view the additional rounds of testimony are unnecessary.

Staff states that its counsel has conferred with SROA and Sunriver and that no party objects to Staff's motion.

For good cause shown, Staff's motion is granted. The dates set for the filing of Staff/Intervenor rebuttal testimony and Sunriver surrebuttal testimony are vacated.
