**RULING**

**DISPOSTION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED**

On October 16, 2019, Staff filed a motion seeking to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. The motion also served as a Status Report, as requested on October 10, 2019. Staff explains that substantial progress continues to be made in settlement discussions, and parties have agreed that a suspension of the procedural schedule is warranted at this time. Staff requests expedited treatment in accordance with OAR 860-001-0420(6). Staff states that no other parties to this proceeding, object to the motion.

**RULING**

I find that good cause had been demonstrated to suspend the procedural schedule. Therefore, Staff's motion is granted and the procedural schedule is suspended. In the event parties fail to reach a settlement, a revised procedural schedule will be set. Staff is directed to provide a status update no later than close of business on November 15, 2019.
