RULING

**DISPOSTION: MOTION GRANTED, PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE SUSPENDED**

On January 23, 2020, Staff filed a motion seeking to suspend the procedural schedule in this docket. The motion stated all parties to this proceeding have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all issues in this case. The Stipulating Parties propose to file a stipulation and joint supporting testimony in this proceeding no later than February 7, 2020. Staff requests expedited treatment, and in accordance with OAR 860-001-0420(6). Staff states that no other parties to this proceeding object to the motion.

**RULING**

I find that good cause had been demonstrated to suspend the procedural schedule. Therefore, Staff's motion is granted and the procedural schedule is suspended. In the event parties fail to reach a settlement, a revised procedural schedule will be set. Staff is directed to provide a status update no later than close of business on February 7, 2020.
