On November 14, 2007, a prehearing conference was held in Salem, Oregon, in the above-captioned docket. The primary purpose of the prehearing conference was to establish a procedural schedule for the docket.

Identification of the Parties

The following parties appeared at the conference: Stephanie Andrus and Ed Durrenberger on behalf of Commission Staff (Staff); Douglas Tingey and Patrick Hager on behalf of Portland General Electric Company (PGE); Lowrey Brown via telephone on behalf of the Citizens’ Utility Board; and Andrew Harris via telephone on behalf of the Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities. In addition, Jacques Grant appeared via telephone on behalf of YAM Services. Mr. Grant indicated that he is requesting “interested person” status at this time. If Mr. Grant would like to actively participate in this proceeding, he will need to file a petition to intervene as a party.
