RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTIONS TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On November 4, 2024, Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) filed motions to allow Donovan E. Walker and Megan Goicoechea Allen to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The statements of Donovan E. Walker and Megan Goicoechea Allen accompanied the motion. Donovan E. Walker and Megan Goicoechea Allen states that they will associate with Adam Lowney, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motions for admission *pro hac vice* and find that they comply with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motions to admit Donovan E. Walker and Megan Goicoechea Allen as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power are granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
