RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On November 4, 2024, Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) filed a motion to allow Donovan E. Walker to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The statement of Mr. Donovan E. Walker accompanied the motion. Mr. Donovan E. Walker, states that he will associate with Adam Lowney an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Donovan E. Walker as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
