- I. Non-PSPS Division 300 Rules** – changes proposed by the Joint Utilities to the remainder of the Division 300 rules; any other changes suggested by stakeholders.
- II. Exemptions from Local Tree Trimming Ordinances** – what local ordinances are at issue and how can we craft a narrowly tailored exemption that does not preempt local law any more than necessary; what notification to the local governmental entity is necessary.
