





**On April 2, 2009 Pacific Power** filed an application with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) for a general rate increase to recover costs primarily related to capital additions, including two new natural gas generating plants and three new wind resources. These investments were made to provide our customers with the electric service they rely on and expect, and to meet the requirements of the state's renewable portfolio standards. For these reasons, as well as other factors explained in the application, Pacific Power is seeking an annual price increase of \$92.1 million or about 9.1 percent. If this application is approved, the average residential customer using 950 kilowatt-hours per month will see an increase of approximately \$5.12 per month.

As proposed, the net effect of the rate increase across customer groups is as follows:

• Residential	6.3%
• Small General Service (Schedule 23)	13.7%
• General Service 31-200 kw (Schedule 28)	9.7%
• General Service 201-999 kw (Schedule 30)	9.7%
• Large General Service >= 1,000 kw (Schedule 48)	13.7%
• Agricultural Pumping Service (Schedule 41)	17.5%
• Street lighting	17.5%
• Overall	9.1%

If approved by the OPUC, the requested increase would take effect no later than February 3, 2010. Even with this rate increase, Pacific Power will continue to be one of the lowest cost electricity providers in the region. Pacific Power serves about 580,000 customers in Oregon.

On April 2, 2009 Pacific Power filed an application with the Oregon Commission (OPUC) for a general rate increase to recover costs prior additions, including two new natural gas generating plants and three new. These investments were made to provide our customers with the electric on and expect, and to meet the requirements of the state's renewable. For these reasons, as well as other factors explained in the application seeking an annual price increase of \$92.1 million or about 9.1 percent approved, the average residential customer using 950 kilowatt-hours per increase of approximately \$5.12 per month.
