UM 2111 Interconnection Modernization Process – Schedule Update

This letter announces future workshops in the UM 2111 docket for Phase 2 as well as the scope for this phase.

As discussed in the September 27, 2024, workshop, Staff is proposing two work streams. One of the workstreams will focus on technical questions related to DTT and requirements for disconnect switches, metering communications, and related issues. Staff will send questions to the service list for the workshop at least one week prior. The initial workshop for this workstream is scheduled for December 5 from 1:00-4:00.

The second workstream will focus on enforceable timelines for interconnection. This workstream will look at issue with completing interconnections, and potential solutions to help with the process. The initial workshop in this workstream will be held on December 17 from 9:00-12:00. Staff is planning to request a contested case to address the policy issues associated with interconnection delays in the first quarter of 2025.

Staff would also like to set a workshop for January 22, 2025, from 9:00-12:00 to discuss utility handbooks which would address the following from Order No. 24-068:

(W)e direct Staff to hold a workshop or similar process to review and collect feedback on utility handbooks at least annually in order to determine whether Commission engagement with any issues related to the process and content of the utility handbook is warranted.

The January 22 workshop will also include further discussion in the technical workstream, with additional details to follow closer to the actual date.
