To avoid the possibility of an *ex parte* communication under OAR 860-001-0340, I am providing notice to the parties that the Commissioners may address issues raised in this proceeding in an upcoming hearing.

On January 21, 2026, a hearing will be held in docket UM 2377, Investigation into Marginal Cost Study Treatment of Costs for Large Customers and Further Modifications to Portland General Electric Company's Rule C and Rule I. The hearing will include Commissioner questions of witnesses who have filed testimony in that proceeding.

The discussion at this hearing has the potential to address issues that have been raised in this contested case proceeding, including the standards by which a cost or investment should be characterized as for the purpose of compliance with HB 2021 or other drivers. Accordingly, parties are advised that topics relating to issues raised in this docket may be addressed at the hearing on January 21, 2026.
