SUBJECT: UNITED TELEPHONE COMPANY OF THE NORTHWEST: (Docket No. PL128/Advice No. 19-005) Introduces CenturyLink Business Bundle Preferred.

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent.

The filing was submitted on June 12, 2019, and will go into effect on June 14, 2019. United Telephone Company of the Northwest (United) proposes to introduce CenturyLink Business Bundle Preferred, a packaged service available to business customers. Under the CenturyLink Price Plan (Docket No. UM 1908, Order No. 18-359, dated September 28, 2018) CenturyLink companies may file changes to price-listed services with one day notice.

Telecommunications utilities are required under ORS 759.175 to submit filings to the Commission whenever they intend to change their rates, terms, or conditions of service.

CenturyLink Business Bundle Preferred is an optional enrollment plan that allows business customers (with up to twenty-five access points and/or key trunks) who subscribe to qualifying products and service to receive local exchange service and additional features and services for a flat monthly rate. Business customers must subscribe to the following services provided by CenturyLink or a CenturyLink affiliate: CenturyLink Business Bundle Unlimited Plan B long distance, and Non-regulated 1.5 Mbps or greater High-speed Internet on a month-to-month basis or under a two-year term minimum commitment.

The filing adds United Telephone Co of the NW Price List, Exchange Services, Section 5, CENTURYLINK BUSINESS BUNDLE, subsection B.1.c and subsection C.2.a&b.
